Use of Funds Plan
American Rescue Plan (ESSER III)

School districts allocated ARP funds must develop a Use of Funds plan and submit it within 90 days of funds being received. School districts must also make the Use of Funds plan available to the public and post the plan on the District website.

As per the American Rescue Plan requirements, 20% of it must be allocated to learning loss.

 - Summer School Programs & Materials - \$30,000

- After-School Programming - \$248,774
 - After school Transportation- \$158,774
 - After School Programs and Materials - \$90,000

- Technology - \$605,265
 - Technology Support - \$335,265
 - Technology Materials and Supplies (software, management systems)- \$150,000
 - Technology Equipment (zoom rooms, projection systems) - \$120,000

- Other Instructional- \$536,854
 - Professional development Support \$509,275
 - Materials and supplies 27,579
(COVID prevention, Social Emotional Learning, Math, Literacy, EL/Bilingual, data analysis, Learning Disabilities, etc..)

- Health Supplies- Mental Health/Physical Health -\$386,673
 - Nurse \$152,792
 - Social Work Support \$203,881
 - PPE \$30,000

- Food Service Supplies- \$30,000

- Building Supplies and Maintenance - \$2,844,193
 - Custodial Supplies & Air Purifiers
 - Custodial Staff
 - Building Maintenance and Repair
